CARE & MAINTENANCE GUIDE

Your mudd. concrete sink is a natural, porous, resilient and durable material. The material acts similarly to other natural stones and may darken while in contact with water and other substances. During an initial wearing-in period, the surface may develop a patina, but through regular use and maintenance, the variations exhibited on your sink will lessen over time.

CARE

- Regularly wipe surface with damp microfiber cloth and leave to dry
- Clean up oily or acidic substances on the sink surface as soon as possible to avoid staining and/or discoloration

CAUTION

- DO NOT USE abrasives or cleaning/bathroom chemicals
- Avoid contact with oil based and/or acidic products
 - Acidic, citrus or vinegar based products may leave a light stain
 - Oil based products may leave a dark stain that will fade over time
- Do not leave your sink full with water for extended periods of time
- Do not leave standing water in your sink for extended periods of time
- Heavy or sharp instruments across the surface can cause scratches and damage the sealer
- Chips may occur if struck by another hard object and are not easily repaired
